NEW MOBILE MRI HIGHLIGHTS CONTINUED INVESTMENT IN LOCAL COMMUNITY SERVICES

El Campo Memorial Hospital's investment in new Magnetic Resonance Imaging equipment -- commonly known as an MRI machine -- gives patients local access to the latest imaging technology without a long commute.

Amy Schoppe, Mid Coast Health System director of radiology, said the new equipment complements other areas of imaging investment such as a new 3D mammography

system thanks to additional support of the El Campo Medical Foundation. "We know that easier access to imaging systems locally reduce barriers and obstacles that impede positive outcomes for patients," Schoppe said. "The new equipment are physical representations of the ongoing commitment our entire care team has for patients from our front office staff to our nurses, physicians, and other specialists."

Brett Kirkham, CEO of Mid Coast Health System, the investments in new, updated equipment are intended to provide a high level of quality to ensure great care while also ensuring availability locally for convenience -- a critical component in developing a strong healthcare infrastructure.

"This investment is a great asset for our patients, providing advanced technology locally and serves as the latest example of our commitment to keeping care close to home where we can. This is important not only for the convenience of parents and caretakers, but also for our businesses and schools so that patients don't have to miss out on work and classes to get the imaging they need," Kirkham said.

ECMH APPROVED BY FEMA TO INSTALL NEW ROOF

El Campo Memorial Hospital officials worked with the Federal Emergency Management Agency to replace roof damage from July 2024's Hurricane Beryl.

Damage from the aftermath of the storm remains evident across the region, and with new funds appropriated as [part of FEMA's response, the entire roof will be replaced, said Brett Kirkham, Mid Coast Health System CEO.

"The team has worked directly with FEMA over the last five months, and we are excited to announce the repairs for the entire facility," Kirkham said.

Roof installation has already begun and will continue through February of 2025.

EL CAMPO MEDICAL FOUNDATION SECURES NEW 3D MAMMOGRAPHY

Recent advances in imaging technology, particularly 3D mammography, are revolutionizing the way breast cancer is detected and diagnosed.

Pamela Hunt, ECMP executive director, led fundraising efforts through a campaign that included additional grant requests and local philanthropy. She said local support in collaboration with hospital leaders is part of the commitment to expand the strength of services offered at Mid Coast Women's Health Center in El Campo.

"Breast cancer is one of the most common cancers among women, and early detection remains the cornerstone of successful treatment," said Robert Ogdee, MD with Mid Coast Women's Health Center.

Unlike traditional 2D mammography, which captures flat images of the breast, 3D mammography creates a series of detailed images from multiple angles. These images are compiled into a three-dimensional representation, allowing radiologists to examine breast tissue layer by layer, Schoppe said. This enhanced visualization reduces the chances of missing abnormalities that might be hidden in overlapping tissue.

3. Conduct Routine Assessments: These may include measurements of your height, weight, and blood pressure, as well as cognitive and functional assessments.
4. Review Medications: Discussing your prescriptions and over-the-counter medications ensures they're safe, effective, and appropriate for your current health.
5. Identify Risk Factors: Your provider will evaluate potential health concerns, such as fall risks, depression, or memory issues, and suggest steps to address them.
